In school, the timings for Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday will follow the normal school day. Term will **finish at midday** on Friday 19th July.

Students are permitted to wear non-uniform clothes for Enrichment Days, however, on each day there will be some physical activities and therefore students should wear clothing and footwear suitable for this. They should also bring sun cream, a sun hat and a bottle of water each day. The rules for hair, make-up and accessories will be the same as for a normal school day. Vest tops, shorts and cropped tops are permitted if it is hot (no spaghetti straps please) and these should be day wear and not beach or party wear.

As your child will be involved in Sports Day on Wednesday 17th July, can I ask that they wear either their house t-shirt or a t-shirt in their house colour as well as their PE kit, including PE shorts and trainers. Students are also permitted to wear face paint in their house colour on this day if they choose to. There will also be a range of confectionery for sale during the day and students are therefore invited to bring in some small change with them if they would like to purchase these.

On Thursday 18th July, Year 7 will be taking part in an exciting STEAM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts, and Mathematics) morning. One of the activities planned for the STEAM day is gardening. If your child has gardening gloves at home, we would greatly appreciate it if they could bring them along. We are thrilled to offer our students this opportunity to explore and engage in different STEAM activities. We look forward to a fun-filled and educational day for all our students.
